A BookSnap Book Review is a fun and innovative way to create a book review in a snap! Originally created to be used on SnapChat by educator Tara Martin, BookSnaps are a quick glimpse of a book inside and out to make choosing a book easy!

For our purposes, your review will use Google Slides to create a unique “snapshot” or glimpse of a book that you choose to review. In the slide you will include **appropriate** visual clues and text sharing what you liked or did not like about it, your personal opinion as to why or why not and any additional images, graphics or emojis that help support your opinion of the book.

The main elements of a BookSnap uses a Google slide as a blank canvas and must include:

1. A picture of the book (that must include the full title and author of the book).
2. A brief summary of the book (no spoilers please!)
3. Text explaining what you liked or disliked about the book.
4. Visually represent your thoughts of the book you chose using Images, pictures that help readers get a sense of what the book is about
5. A rating on a scale of 1-5

When your BookSnap is complete, you will download it to a **JPEG** or **PNG** and submit it to me to be posted on the website.
