

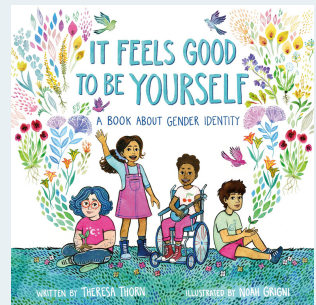
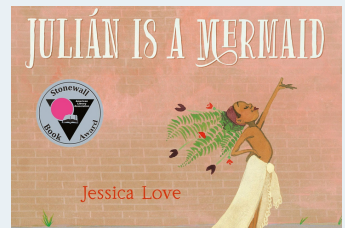


# Read with Pride

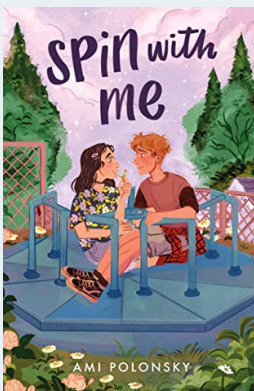
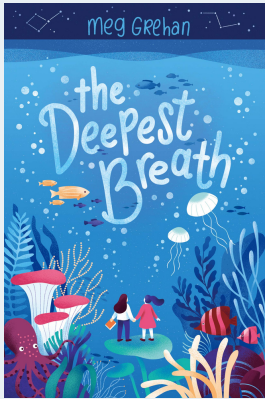
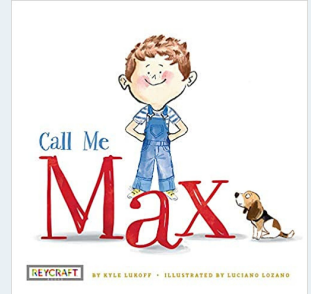
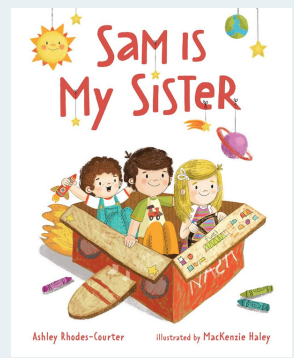
